ARTIST STATEMENT

I saw my personal story in the people making a living within the constraints of a lower-middle class existence. An existence lived between the political and the personal.

There is an interesting paradox here, the happiness, the anger, the love, the struggle with a pilitisized human experience.

My work aims to express the many intersections between systems of power and lived experience. Composed in the structure of magazine covers / poster, an attempt to attract the viewer into buying into this story.

The process always starts with the layering of stories on top of stories. A complex layering of small details that make-up a human life. Then the HERO figure with a halo of big brands. As though to promise a solution.

I draw on a distinct South African trope, attempting to communicate with those that seem to already innately recognize.




