A London-based artist of Algerian and Italian descent, my work spans visual and performance art, incorporating improvisational techniques to explore themes of social justice, identity, and the inner child. My figurative paintings, created with oil, charcoal, or watercolours, evoke a child-like sensibility, drawing from personal memories and relationships. I express social justice and empowerment through mixed media, natural materials such as henna, beeswax, and sand, and experimental performance art. Embracing unconventional materials, I often work with unstretched canvases and fabrics, pushing the boundaries of spatial and material exploration. I hold a Certificate in Fine Art from the Art Academy London and have exhibited internationally and within the UK, including at the Venice Biennale (2024), P21 Gallery London (2021, 2024), and XYZ Gallery London (2025).
